

Photo Album



Supplies included: 2 pieces of colored cardstock, 8.5 pieces of white cardstock, nail, cord Not included: hammer, glue or tape, pencil

- 1. Align all 10 full pieces of cardstock, using the colored pieces as the front and back cover.
- 2. Lay it down in front of you vertically. On the top left of your front colored piece of paper use your pencil to make a mark about 1 inch in from the side and about 3/4 inch down from the top. Do the same on the top right side so you have two pencil marks on the top of your colored piece of paper (Figure 1).
- 3. Use your hammer to drive the nail through each of those marks, making sure to go through all 10 pieces (Figure 2). I placed a piece of cardboard I had underneath to ensure no nail mark ended up on my hard surface. You could also take it briefly outside to nail or anywhere in your home that you prefer for this step.
- 4. Thread first one end of the cord then the other through the holes you've made (Figure 3). You may find it easiest to wiggle the nail to enlarge the holes and/or thread the cord through each page individually. Then tie the loose ends together in a bow (Figure 4).
- 5. Use the remaining half sheet of cardstock to create a label for the cover of your album (Figure 5). Glue or tape it on.
- 6. Glue or tape in your favorite photos or keepsakes!
